Please read carefully before to enroll your students to CMIT ELEMENTARY after-school clubs.

After- school club information

**** The after school clubs sign-up due date is on October 19, 2015. The sign-up link will be post in our website on October 2, 2015 and send via e-mail. You may also contact your home-room teacher for the link. ****

*******The after school clubs begin on October 26, 2015.*******

We are requesting you not to sign-up more than one club. If there is a free spot available by October 26.You may contact club supervisors to request for the second club enrollment. Sign-up more than one club can be the reason of your student's dis-enrollment from all clubs.

The clubs supervisor will be in charge for club enrollment, dis-enrollment, club location, date, time etc.... Please contact your club supervisor for any questions related to the clubs after enrollment.

After-school club guidelines

1. Attendance at all meetings is mandatory (except for sickness). Each student will be allowed to miss two club meetings each semester (consecutively). The third absence will result in the student's removal from the club.

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2. Students must be picked up from each meeting on time at the drop-off location (Cafeteria). TWO LATE PICKUPS WILL END THE STUDENT'S MEMBERSHIP.
3. All clubs are dismissed at 04:00 pm.
4. Students are expected to follow all club rules and behavior expectations. Failure to follow will result in dismissal from that club. One written warning will be sent home for parent signature. Club sponsor will be informed of inappropriate behavior in the classroom and the student will be dismissed from the club.
5. Failure to meet academic expectations in the classroom will result in dismissal from a club.
